Meeting Minutes

MAY 1, 2012

I. Call to order

George Klemmer called to order the regular meeting of the Montour Football Boosters at 7:05 on MAY 1, 2012 in the Montour High School cafeteria.

George Klemmer welcomed all the new families and introduced the board.

All registration materials were collected.

The purpose of the booster organization was explained and no questions were asked.

Fundraising was discussed, including the Lift-A-Thon in June, Golf Outing, Coaches card Sale and the Outback Steakhouse Event.

We will be asking the Middle school players to be more involved as they are receiving more benefits than in previous years, such as workout gear, after game sandwiches and an end of season party.

We will be expecting each Middle school and Freshman player to raise a minimum of \$150.00 each and Varsity players will raise in excess of 350.00 per player.

We are trying to avoid being a "pay to participate" program.

All parents are expected to participate in the game activities, including concession stand, 50/50 sales and program sales.

The Booster organization will not supply benefits to those who do not participate.

II. Treasurers report

Judy Bocek presented the preliminary coaches budget for the 2012-13 season.

With a budget of \$75,000.00, Judy emphasized the need for everyone to fundraise. Costs have increased due to increased player numbers and an increase in supply costs. Judy broke down the budget and cost per player to participate.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Berni Parrish made available, the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes are available on the MFB website. There were no changes or additions.

IV. Coaches report

- a) Field practice for Varsity players will begin every Monday and Tuesday during May, at 5:30 pm. No practice Memorial Day.
- b) The High School weight room is open every day after school to all High school students. Middle school players will be able to use the weight room under a supervised schedule, during the summer months.
- c) Physicals need to be completed before the start of camp. There will be free physicals announced at a future date.
- d) Please check the website for any and all schedules.

- e) The Chartiers Valley game on Friday 9/7/12 has been rescheduled to air on Root Sports Network on Thursday 9/6/12.
- f) The 7th, 8th and 9th grades will be meeting and getting the summer schedule within the month.
- g) During the summer practice sessions, all players will be starting practice together and then break out into their own groups. This will include the Middle school players.
- h) We have over 200 sign-ups this year and everything will be done to make sure their experience as positive as possible.
- i) The 7th, 8th and 9th grade players will need to have a pair of molded spikes by June 11th. Practices will start at 4:30 pm.

V. New Business

- a) The positions of President, Treasurer and Secretary will be open for elections in January of 2013. People should be thinking about potential candidates.
- b) We will need a chairperson for the program committee. Please contact any of the board members as soon as possible if you are interested.

VI. Old Business

- a) Rob Macek spoke about the specifics of the June Lift-A-Thon and our partnership with Magee Research Institute. We will be working with them by sharing our event information through their corporate sponsorships. More information is available by contacting Berni Parrish.
- b) Jeff Jablonski spoke about the upcoming Golf Outing and the need to get our advertising and signups done early. The Golf Outing will be held on August 11th.
- c) The summer kick-off picnic will be chaired by Jen Mihelcic and will be held on August 10th. All players and families are invited. Everyone will be assigned a donation .
- d) The official Varsity "Summer Camp" starts on August 13th and will go into the middle of the next week.
- e) The coaches card sale will be held on Sunday August 12th and is mandatory for all players to participate.
- f) Kara Hoffman spoke about needing volunteers to serve lunch at the football camp. A sign-up sheet will be available at the June meeting. All parents 7th - 12th grade are welcome to help. It is fun.
- g) Please be prepared to sign up for your concession stand duty and any other committee that may interest you at the June meeting. Otherwise, you will be assigned by the board.
- h) The next monthly meeting of the Montour Football Boosters will be held on June 5th.
